



CODE OF CONDUCT



Congratulations and Welcome to LFC! We are very excited to have a great group of players and parents and are looking forward to an exciting season of soccer! Although most of you know the items that are discussed below, as a reminder and a re-statement, please take note to the following:

1. **PLAYING TIME:** Players are not guaranteed time on the field; however, we will try to make it as fair as possible and each player will get playing time during each game. Playing time will be earned and based upon performance and attendance at practice.
2. **PRACTICE:** Once the season starts, most teams should practice at least 2 times a week, possibly more. Practices times and dates will be determined by the assigned coaches or team manager, as well as length of time per practice. Practices are VERY important and essential for every child's development. PLEASE CONTACT THE COACH if any practices should be missed.
3. **UNIFORMS:** Wear your uniform proudly and take good care of it. The uniforms are the representation of your team, your club and yourself. If damaged, destroyed, lost or stolen, you will be responsible for replacing it.
4. **COMMITMENT:** The team want a FULL commitment from both its players AND parents. We are aware that some of the players may be involved with another sports and activities that may conflict with the schedule. That being said you are required to make one scheduled practice except for reasons being: sick, out of town, family responsibilities, and schooling. Missing more than one scheduled practice per week for any other activities or sports may result in consequences that will be determined by the teams coach.
5. **EXPENSES:** The approximate expenses for the year should be provided by the team manager. This amount DOES NOT include any travel expenses (i.e. hotel, meals, gas, etc.). If you are capable of getting donations from businesses, they will be greatly appreciated.
6. **COMMUNICATION:** If there is anything you are not happy about, please speak with your team manager and coaches 1st. We are all passionate about our children as well as protective! With that circumstances can sometimes get out of control and confrontation will emerge. Please try to reframe from certain tendencies and keep your composure. Any questions pertaining to a game should wait, at least, 24 hours after for things to be thought about and processed before continuing.
